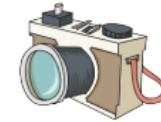
Living, not living or never alive?

Habitats

A habitat is where a living thing lives. Habitats provide things that living things need for the life processes such as **food, water and air**.

Examples of micro-habitats:

- flower beds
- trees
- bushes
- under rocks/logs
- ponds
- in the grass

Examples of large habitats:

- desert
- mountains
- polar regions
- jungle
- ocean
- savannah
