English

Can you draw a picture of a plant and then label it?

Can you describe the lifecycle of a frog using sequencing words (then/next)?

Maths

Investigate the coins in your piggy bank. Can you identify the names of different coins? Can you say which coin is bigger in value?

Explore fruit and vegetables at home in the fridge. Can you talk about their weight? Which is heaviest/lightest?

Understanding the World

Can you plant your own bean/bulb/seeds at home? Observe what happens over time.

Enjoy a spring-time walk and take photos of the different plants and animals you notice. Perhaps draw a picture!

Visit some baby animals at the farm.
