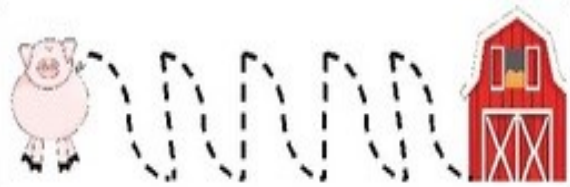


Expressive Arts & Design

PRIME AREAS

Communication & Language

We are learning to...

Listen with increased attention to sounds.
Remember and sing entire songs.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We are learning to...

Talk with others to resolve conflicts.
Talk about our feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry', or 'worried'.
Play with one or more friend, extending and elaborating play ideas.

Physical Development

We are learning to...

Use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors.
Show a preference for a dominant hand.

SPECIFIC AREAS

Literacy

We are learning to...

Recognise words with the same initial letter sounds.
Engage in extended conversations about stories.
Write some letters and attempt to write all of our name.

Maths

We are learning to...

Count the farm animals: saying one number name for each animal in order.
Understand position through words alone e.g. the duck is *under* the fence.
Compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'.

Understanding the World

We are learning to...

Name animals and their young.
Look at similarities, differences and features of animals; paws, hooves, feathers, wings, tails etc.
