PRIME AREAS

Communication & Language

We are learning...

- To articulate our ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences
- To connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives.
- To describe events in some detail.
- To retell a familiar story using some exact repetition and some in their own words.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We are learning...

- To build constructive and respectful relationships, through good sharing, co-operation and acts of kindness.

Physical Development— Fine Motor

SPECIFIC AREAS

Literacy—Reading

Literacy—Writing
