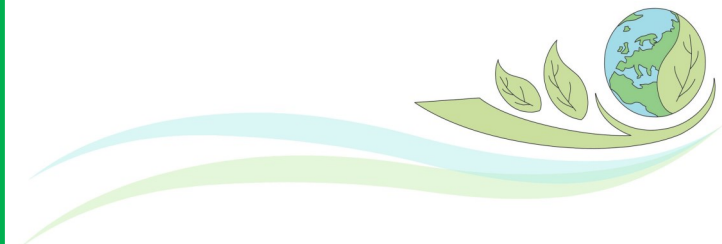

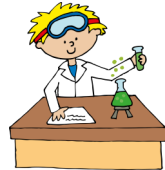


As readers and writers we will be ...
