

As readers and writers we will be...

- Reading the stories of Paddington Bear to help us learn more about London from a fictional story point of view.
- Ensuring that we are using capital letters and full stops correctly within our sentences.
- Recapping, defining and identifying what nouns, verbs and adjectives are correctly.
- Understanding what proper nouns are and using them in our writing.
- Focussing on different reading strands in a range of fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Learning how to write a set of instructions using time adverbials.

As scientists we will be...

- Describing world habitats and identifying animals that live in them.
- Learning how living things within specific habitats rely on each other.
- Understanding how food chains are created and use the correct terminology of producer, consumer and predator.
- Knowing what type of eater each animal is within a food chain.
- Discussing what we have learnt about living things and their habitats this term.

As creative learners we will be...

- Designing and making Christmas cards and calendars using a range of media.
- Learning a range of Christmas songs to prepare for the festive season.
- Rehearsing for our Christmas Production.
- Learning how to make a quick cheese pizza.
- Working on our pencil skills to create different patterns and textures within our drawings.



As mathematicians we will be...

- Continuing to learn different methods to answer addition and subtraction number sentences.
- Able to solve a range of problems involving addition and subtraction.

Year 1

- Sorting and recognising 2D and 3D shapes.
- Working on our place value of numbers to 20.

Year 2

- Counting money in pounds and pence.
- Making the same amount of money in different ways.
- Finding the total, difference and then working out change.

As explorers we will be...

- Identifying our location within the world.
- Learning about the seven different continents of the world.
- Locating the four countries and their capital cities in the UK.
- Using our map skills to locate London on different maps.
- Learning about the physical and human features of London.
- Using our map skills to plan routes around London focussing on the different landmarks and modes of transport.
- Refining our compass directions to help with our map work.
- Choosing key vocabulary to help us describe London.

As linguists we will be...

- Learning the correct pronunciation of French words .
- Listening and responding to songs and rhymes.
- Writing simple words and phrases to convey meaning.

In PSHE our theme this half term is Celebrating Differences. We will be ...

- Understanding that sometimes assumptions are made about boys and girls.
- Learning that sometimes bullying is about difference.
- Recognising what is right and wrong and how to look after ourselves.
