Mary Anning is still remembered today for her important work as a palaeontologist. There is a special sign on her home and a museum all about her in Lyme Regis.








Roar Roar Dinosaur!








Palaeontololgists have found the remains of dinosaur bones & eggs all around the world. This has given us important information about their appearance, diet, behaviours and habitats.
